To enable the Membership Secretary to process your membership, the following forms should be completed and returned to the club, along with the correct membership fee and first month's swimming fees:

1. The membership application form, including the primary e-mail address, as this will be the main form of communication. If your details change it is important you give us your new details by emailing to either the Membership Secretary or Club Secretary.
2. A Standing Order Mandate should be completed and handed in. One Standing Order Mandate per family group is preferred, as it prevents banking errors. Fees are payable on the first of each month, in advance.
